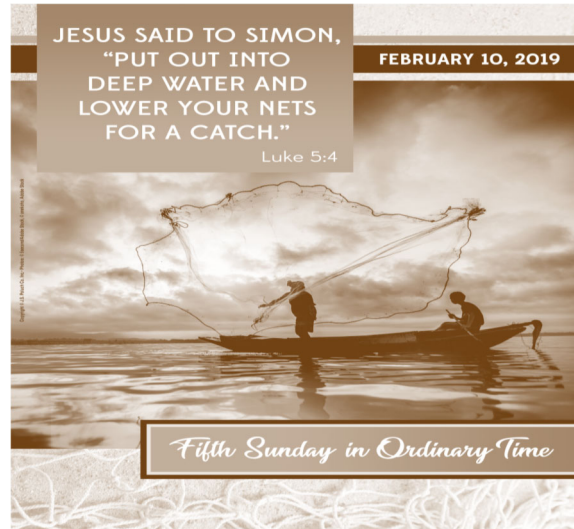

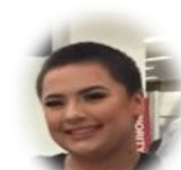

He retired at the age of 50 and the day afterward started volunteer work with Mother Teresa's sisters, the Missionaries of Charity, at a hospice in Pacifica. He was ordained as a permanent deacon in May 2014. Deacon Charles and his wife Bobbie have been blessed with six children and eight grandchildren, which keeps them pretty busy.
